

## Northern Michigan Antique-Flywheelers Club Showground Rules and Safety Information

- Electrical hook-ups during show week are available on a limited basis for medical purposes only.
- **Generator Curfew:** 10:30 p.m. till 7:00 a.m.
- Small tractors, garden tractors, and golf carts may be parked at your campsite.
- Camping or parking is not allowed inside the parade route circle.
- **Only handicapped and emergency vehicles are allowed on the showground.** All golf carts and personal transportation vehicles are for official or handicapped use only. These vehicles must register and be issued a club permit at the registration booth south of the Museum. Any vehicle without a club permit will be asked to leave the show area.
- **Dogs or other animals are not permitted in the show area.** There shall be no loose animals on the showground *Sunday prior to the show until Monday after the show*. Exhibitors, campers, and flea market vendors must keep their pets tethered at their site. Please do not use the pine tree area as a dog walk. Remember to clean up after your pet.
- **Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the showground.**
- **Drivers operating motor vehicles during organized activities must have a valid driver's license.** The board must approve exceptions.
- **For safety reasons, no riding on drawbars or fenders is allowed.** Riders are allowed on moving vehicles only in appropriate seats.
- Any shuttle, wagon, or trailer, etc. carrying passengers must have safety chains, a steel tongue (unless otherwise approved), and the ball hitch or hitch pin must be secured with a safety pin.
- An operator must be present **ON** the tractor when running belted equipment with the exception of the Veneer Mill, which has a kill switch.
- All vehicles, **including golf carts**, must have running lights on when being operated after dark.
- All horses must be pre-authorized. Contact the board prior to show time.
- Parking for all utility and equipment trailers is located in the East Parking Area located across the U.S 131 highway.
